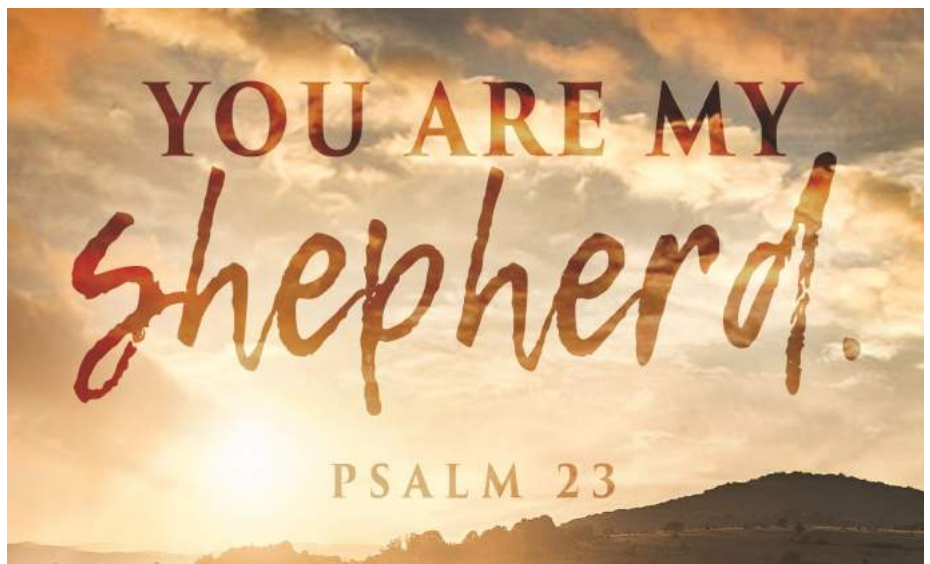

St. James the Apostle | July 25

Saint James the Apostle is also called James, son of Zebedee, or James the Greater to distinguish him from the other James in Jesus' group of twelve. Most of what we know about Saint James is recorded in the New Testament. He and his brother John were collected by Jesus along the sea of Galilee. Matthew 4:18-22 tells the story of Jesus calling first Simon Peter and his brother Andrew and then the sons of Zebedee. In Mark 3:17 the brothers receive a nickname from Jesus who calls them "sons of thunder" because of their many extreme reactions, like that in Luke 9:54 when they offer to call down fire on a Samaritan village.

Saint James was part of Jesus' intimate circle, a witness to the Transfiguration, the resurrection of Jairus' daughter, and the agony in the garden of Gethsemane. In A.D. 44 Herod Agrippa had "James, the brother of John, killed by the sword." (Acts 12:2) He is the only apostle whose martyrdom is written of in the New Testament.

According to Spanish tradition, his body was taken to Santiago de Compostela, Spain where his relics were rediscovered in 9th century. This tradition has sometimes been attributed to a passage in the Song of Roland which tells of St. James appearing to Charlemagne in a dream, prophesying that Charlemagne would conquer the Moors in Spain. This was followed by a vision of stars which if followed would lead to the saint's lost tomb. In the Middle Ages Compostela was a hugely popular pilgrimage site. The saint's relics continue to rest in the cathedral there and one can still undertake the pilgrimage.



Santiago Apóstol | 25 de Julio

Santiago Apóstol también es llamado Santiago, hijo de Zebedeo, o Santiago el Mayor, para distinguirlo de los otros Santiago del grupo de los doce de Jesús. La mayor parte de lo que sabemos de Santiago está registrado en el Nuevo Testamento. Él y su hermano Juan fueron recogidos por Jesús junto al mar de Galilea. Mateo 4:18-22 narra la historia de Jesús llamando primero a Simón Pedro y a su hermano Andrés y luego a los hijos de Zebedeo. En Marcos 3,17 los hermanos reciben un apodo por parte de Jesús, que los llama "hijos del trueno" por sus muchas reacciones extremas, como la de Lucas 9,54 cuando se ofrecen a hacer caer fuego sobre una aldea samaritana.

Santiago formó parte del círculo íntimo de Jesús, testigo de la Transfiguración, de la resurrección de la hija de Darío y de la agonía en el jardín de Getsemaní. En el año 44 D.C. Herodes Agripa hizo "matar a espada a Santiago, hermano de Juan". (Hechos 12:2) Es el único apóstol de cuyo martirio se tiene noticia en el Nuevo Testamento.

Según la tradición española, su cuerpo fue trasladado a Santiago de Compostela, donde sus reliquias fueron redescubiertas en el siglo IX. Esta tradición se ha atribuido a veces a un pasaje de la Canción de Roldán que cuenta que Santiago se le apareció a Carlomagno en sueños, profetizándole que conquistaría a los moros en España. A esto siguió una visión de estrellas que, si se seguían, conducirían a la tumba perdida del santo. En la Edad Media, Compostela fue un lugar de peregrinación muy popular. Las reliquias del santo siguen descansando en su catedral y todavía se puede peregrinar hasta allí.
